Project Title: Appointment of Design and Construction Supervision Consultants (DSC) for Multi-Purpose Cyclone Shelters (MPCS) and Missing Roads for NCRMP II in the State of Gujarat

The Government of India has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of National Cyclone Mitigation Project (NCRMP) II in Gujarat, India and intends to apply a part of proceeds for consulting services. The Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority (“GSDMA”), the State Project Implementing Unit (SPIU) in Gujarat State for this project intends to engage a consulting firm as Design and Construction Supervision Consultant (“DSC”) for,

- i. Preparation of architectural, structural, plumbing, drainage and electrical design for construction of Multi-Purpose Cyclone Shelters (MPCS). This would involve site planning, topographical surveys, geo-technical investigations, ground water investigation, wind speeds etc. to support type design of MPCS construction.
- ii. Support to implementing line departments in procurement & contract management, construction supervision, environment and social safeguards compliance, certification, reporting, completion report etc., of MPCS, missing roads and access roads in 15 districts. The Contract duration is expected to be over a period of 24 months with delivery timelines as indicated in TOR.

The Government of India has applied for financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the NCRMP II, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services

The consulting services ("the Services") includes but not limited to:

- a) Preparation of architectural, structural, plumbing, drainage & electrical design for construction of Multi-Purpose Cyclone Shelters (MPCS). This would involve site planning, topographical surveys, geo-technical investigations, ground water investigation, wind speeds etc. to support type design of MPCS construction.
- b) Support to implementing agency in procurement & contract management, construction supervision, environment and social safeguards compliance, certification, reporting, completion report etc., of MPCS, missing roads and access roads in 15 districts. The Contract duration is expected to be over a period of 24 months with delivery timelines as indicated in ToR.

Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority ("GSDMA") is the Project Implementation Unit of this project in Gujarat. The GSDMA now invites eligible Consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria is mentioned below:

1. Specific experience of the Consultant (as a firm) relevant to the Assignment:

- The bidders should have at least 3 similar or equivalent completed/ ongoing projects in last 10 years as Design and Construction Supervision Consultants, each costing not less than INR 100 million (or equivalent US\$) in same or different contracts, in designing Building, Roads, Bridges etc. funded by either central government or donor agencies.
- Average Financial Turnover of the bidders for last 3 years (FY 15-16, FY 16-17, FY 17-18) from consultancy services must be at least INR 150 million (or equivalent US\$).
- Experience of similar assignments in both designing and construction supervision in last 10 years will be considered
- Experience of similar projects funded by Bilateral/ Multilateral Funding Agencies in last 10 years in both designing and construction supervision would be preferred.

- Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture (JV) or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. The submission should clearly state the nature of Association (JV or sub-consultant).

Expressions of interest (EOI) must include:

- Introductory letter on letter head (with complete contact details, name of contact person, mailing address, telephone, fax, email etc.) explaining how the firm is best to deliver the task.
- Organization Profile.
- Annual audited Financial Statement for the last 3 years (FY 15-16, FY 16-17, FY 17-18).
- Short note on the similar projects implemented by the firm pertaining to the shortlisting criteria along with the contact details of past clients.
- Sufficient supporting document to substantiate the claim of the Consultant towards their qualification as per the shortlisting criteria. Supporting documents should include Clients' Completion Certificates and Work Orders for all completed projects and Work Orders for all the on-going projects stating clearly the duration of the projects, the funding agency (if applicable) and the value of the projects.
